HumanWare, part of Essilor since 2013 and the global leader in assistive technology for the blind and visually impaired, has been awarded the biggest contract in its history by the National Library Service in the US to provide the next generation of digital audio book players for members with visual disabilities.

HumanWare is very pleased to have been awarded an unprecedented contract worth \$60 million, its largest to date, to deliver new custom-built, next-generation Digital Talking Book Machines for the National Library Service (NLS), a division of the Library of Congress of the United States.

Through its national network of libraries, the NLS offers a free braille and talking book library service for people with visual disabilities, both cognitive or physical, that prevent them from reading a printed document. The new readers will

replace 450,000 existing outdated digital talking book players.

With its long history in digital talking books, including distribution of over 750,000 Victor Reader Stratus and Streams and a well-earned reputation for excellence, HumanWare is well positioned to deliver a robust, reliable solution that will improve the experience of every NLS member.

HumanWare Inc's mission is to empower those with vision loss to fully participate with their sighted peers, which is a natural extension of Essilor's mission of improving lives by improving sight. The collaboration with HumanWare helps the Group promote access to a full spectrum of vision care options for a larger number of people affected by vision impairments.
